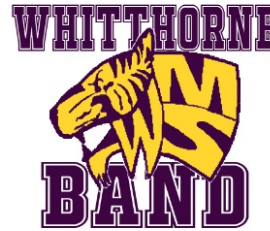

## Materials List for Beginning Band Brass Students

The following is a list of materials that brass students will need in class. There are many other brands that are acceptable that are *not* on this list. If you find an instrument brand, size, etc... that is not on this list please call or email us to make sure it is the right quality and type for your child.

### **Bb Trumpet**

*Reputable Brands:* Yamaha, Bach, Getzen, Holton, and King

*Mouthpiece:* Bach 7c (or 5c) or equivalent size

*Accessories:* Valve Oil, Slide Grease

*Additional Comments:* Make sure there is a 3rd valve slide ring and all slides and valves move freely.

### **\*F Horn**

Double Horns are required. (see school-owned instrument details below)

*Mouthpiece:* Yamaha 30C4 or equivalent size

*Accessories:* Rotor Oil, Slide Grease

### **Trombone**

*Reputable Brands:* Yamaha, Bach, King, Besson, Conn, and Holton

*Mouthpiece:* Bach 6 1/2AL or Yamaha 48

*Accessories:* Slide Lubricant, Tuning Slide Grease

*Additional Comments:* Make sure all slides move freely, and the main slide effortlessly, any dents in the main slide will greatly affect the performance of the instrument

### **\*Euphonium**

*Mouthpiece:* Bach 6 1/2AL or Yamaha 48

*Accessories:* Valve Oil, Tuning Slide Grease

### **\*Tuba**

*Mouthpiece:* Bach 7, Conn Helleberg 7B, or Yamaha 66

*Accessories:* Valve Oil, Tuning Slide Grease

***All students will need Essential Elements 2000 Book 1 published by Hal Leonard. Make sure it is for your specific instrument.***

*\*School-Owned Instruments: Instruments like Horn, Euphonium and Tuba can be very expensive to purchase or rent. Therefore, if your child is chosen to play one of these instruments they will be able to use a school-owned instrument for an annual fee of \$100. Students and Parents will also have to complete the School-Owned Instrument Borrowing Agreement.*
